## Warriors 200 Club – Rules

## Warriors 200 Club Foundation Rules

1. The name of the draw is the Warriors 200 foundation ("the 200 club") regardless of the number of shares.
2. The purpose of this foundation is to raise funds for the sole benefit of Stenhousemuir football club ("the Club").
3. The Lottery will be administered by a Promoter appointed by the board of the Club.
4. 40% of the total annual subscriptions will be paid out in the form of prizes.
5. Prizes will be set on a pro rata basis of the actual numbers of participants at the time of each draw. Prizes could be reduced by 1% for every 2 unallocated membership numbers or unpaid members less than full membership.
  - a. The Lottery shall run from 1st January to 31st December each year.
  - b. The Lottery will be open to anybody aged 16 or over.
  - c. A purchaser of a share becomes a participant in the Lottery.
  - d. Participants are entitled to hold any number of shares.
6. The number of shares in the Lottery shall be limited to 200 and each share shall be allocated a unique number. Membership cards will be issued and only become valid upon receipt of subscriptions.
  - a. Participants will receive their certificate once the paperwork has been completed and the direct debits have been set up.
7. The subscription for each share is £240.00 per annum payable in one payment due annually or 12 equal payments of £20.00 per month collected by standing order.
  - a. All participants must pay in advance by Standing Order
8. There shall be a draw made in each calendar month, draw will be made on Tuesday of the first week of each month.
  - a. Any participants are able to attend the draws, which must be held in the presence of at least 3 witnesses at the football club at a time to suit the promoter or other appointed person from the club. Draw time and location to be advised prior to each draw. Prize winning numbers will be drawn at random using random number selection equipment.
9. Winners will be paid by cheque, which will be sent to the last known address held by the promoter. It is the responsibility of the participant to advise the Promoter of any change of address. Any prize cheque not cashed within 6 months will be deemed a donation to the Club.
  - a. A list of prize winning numbers will be available from the Club website.
10. The Promoter will not pay a prize to any Participant other than the purchaser of a winning share.
11. No Lottery participant will be included in the draw if the subscription has not been received. It is the responsibility of each Participant to make sure they have paid their subscription. The promoter reserves the right to reallocate any number where payment has not been received.
12. Participants can cancel their entry in the Lottery at any time by giving three month's written notice to the Promoter at the Lotteries registered address. Any decision by the Club to end the lottery will also be by three months' notice to all Participants.
13. Under no circumstances can subscriptions be refunded.
14. The Promoter will determine any dispute. An appeal may be made to the Club Management Executive Committee whose decision shall be final.
15. The Lottery is intended to be a private lottery under the provisions of the Gambling Act 2005 Section 1
16. Stenhousemuir Football Club may amend or vary the rules of the lottery at any time.
